Darling was green when green was just a color.

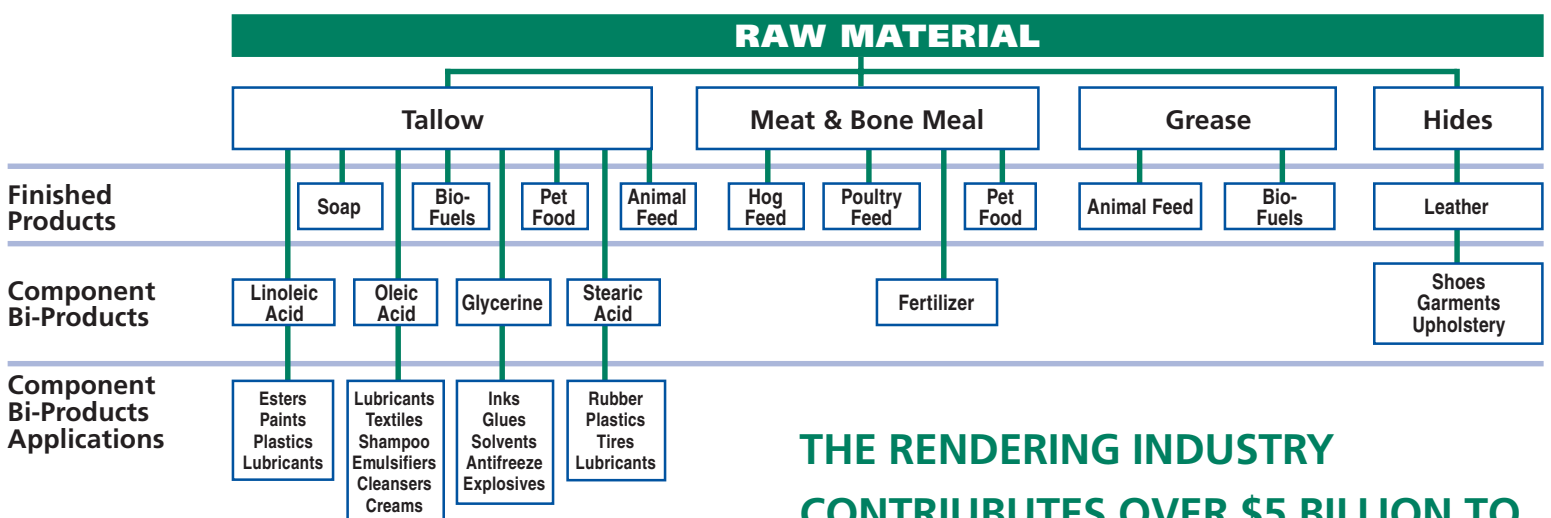
In Darling's early years, the material collected from farmers and butchers was turned into fertilizer and scraps. By the mid-1900s, manufacturers were using the recycled by-products as protein supplements in animal feeds, and later in plastics, jet fuels, chemicals and other commercial products. In several of our facilities, we are using our recycled yellow grease as fuel to produce the steam that keeps those facilities running. And now, as the world's energy resources decline, the opportunity to utilize this material as a bio-fuel is economically feasible and environmentally desirable. Darling is and has always been dedicated to following a philosophy of sustainability, by recycling virtually all of the waste materials collected into useable products in an environmentally safe manner.

Today Darling International is America's leading producer of rendering, recycling and recovery solutions to the nation's food industry.

The only company in the rendering and grease recycling business publicly traded on the U.S. stock exchange, Darling collects and recycles used cooking oil and animal by-products through our coast-to-coast production facilities and supplies critical grease trap cleaning services to restaurants and other food service establishments in many parts of the country.

Finished Products

Darling's facilities are located across the country, where animal and food by-products are recycled into useful finished products sold globally. Innovated product applications are continually being developed by Darling's Research Team. Our fats and oils are used as ingredients in the production of pet food, animal feed and soaps. Oleo-chemical producers use these oils to produce specialty ingredients that are used in paint, rubber, paper, concrete, plastics, lubricants, antifreeze, biofuels and a variety of other consumer and industrial projects. Protein meals are used primarily as additives in pet food and animal feed, and hides are used in the leather industry. Virtually nothing that Darling takes in goes to waste.
